ANTOINE CATALA (47 CANAL, NEW YORK) Catala's self-consciously lo-fi, analog takes on the high-tech digital-media landscape have been a highlight of many New York group shows over the past few years. Appropriating a Rube Goldberg-esque sense of wonder in his approach to both materials and ideas, which conjoins classroom-science-project aesthetics with highbrow semiotics, Catala created work for the 47 Canal show that not only looked like no other recent art but also felt different. His humor and wordplay often mask a decidedly singular and serious practice that I imagine will only continue to bear ever-stranger fruit.
